

ABOUT MURAL MUSIC & ARTS PROJECT

The Mural Music & Arts project ("MMAP") educates, empowers, and inspires youth through participation in the arts. MMAP offers year-round youth development programs, serving the Peninsula and San Francisco. MMAP begin in 2001 as the East Palo Alto Mural Art Project, employing local teens to design and create a mural for every school in the local district. MMAP's murals reflect themes of community, cooperation, equity, justice, environment, and local history. Active community support inspired MMAP to expand and diversity its program to included arts education, Hip Hop music production, and dance. To date, MMAP has served over 681 youth, created 66 murals and produced original music that was written, recorded, and performed by MMAP youth.
